

Willingdon Community School are delighted with their latest Ofsted Inspection Report from the visit on the 13th June 2017. It's official- the school continues to hold a strong 'Good' judgement with elements of outstanding practice. The report records the 'organised, calm and positive ethos' of the school and their students. There have been 'strong relationships' developed between students and staff where 'high expectations' are expected from all parties. The OFSTED inspectors particularly commented on the 'exemplary behaviour' of their students.
