## COMMUNITY SCHOOL

Willingdon Community School are delighted with yet another impressive set of GCSE results against a backdrop of major and significant changes to the examination system. Over 96% of our students achieved five or more GCSE grades including English and Maths. Over 70% of students achieved three levels of progress in both English and Maths. Significant value added for our students achieving an Attainment 8 score of 5.04, meant that the average grade across all students was a grade C. Over a quarter of students passed with three or more A\*/A grades and a fifth of students achieved the full English Baccalaureate.

The results mirrored the success of previous years; Biology GCSE -100% of students gained a C grade or above, over 50% of students achieved in A\*/A grade in Chemistry and Physics and in English Literature 98.5% of students gained a C grade or above. There was a 100% pass rate in Sociology, Catering, Music, French, Computer Science, Geography, Religious Studies, Sports Studies, Travel and Tourism, Design Technology and Art and Design.

High achievers at Willingdon this August 2016 include, Connie Breach, Jack Pye, Olivia Langford, Max Smith, Emily Hughes and Erin McKee who all gained 10 or more A\*/A grades and Katinka Morris who achieved 11 A\*s, the top result in the school. These are remarkable achievements that compare with the very best students across the country.

We would firstly like to thank all of the students for their commitment and determination shown towards their studies. We wish all of the students the very best of luck with their future destinations and look forward to seeing many of them at our Prize Evening later in the year.
