Macbeth Performance – Theatre Royal, Brighton

I am writing to invite your child to a production of William Shakespeare's 'Macbeth' on Friday the 24th January. This afternoon performance will take place in Theatre Royal in Brighton. We study this text as part of our Year 9 curriculum and seeing a live version of the play can greatly increase a student's enjoyment and understanding of the text. It will also help prepare students for their GCSE study of another Shakespeare text, 'Romeo and Juliet'.

Students and staff will make their way from school to Polegate train station and will arrive in Brighton at 12.30pm. From there, students will be taken to the theatre for a 1.15pm start. After the production has finished, students and staff will make their way back to Willingdon School for collection at around 5pm. We will be able to provide more accurate timings closer to the date.

Tickets are very limited and we will offer places on a first-come, first-served basis.

The price of the trip (theatre ticket and train travel) is £20. Students may wish to bring money with them for concessions at the theatre. Please use ParentPay if you would like to book a place. Payment availability should automatically close when the trip is full, but if you do make a payment after all of the places are filled, we will ensure that your money is refunded promptly. ***ParentPay will be open by the end of today to make your payment.***
