UK University & Apprenticeship Fair – Amex Stadium / Tuesday 14th November 2023

We are now able to offer Year 11 students a limited number of places on the UK University and Apprenticeship Fair trip on Tuesday, 14th November, details below. Unfortunately, those students who are studying Spanish have their mock exam on the same day as the trip so they will be unable to attend. Apologies for any disappointment that this may cause.

The UK University & Apprenticeship Fair is a great way for students to explore which university or apprenticeship might be right for them. This informative event will provide students with the opportunity to speak to a multitude of exhibiting universities and apprenticeship providers. These will include Russell Group universities (such as Oxford, Cambridge, Durham & Exeter), red brick (Birmingham, Bristol, Leeds, Liverpool, Manchester, and Sheffield), modern institutions, as well as many of the UK's biggest apprenticeship providers and local colleges. In addition, there will be some seminars that students will be able to attend including UCAS (University & Colleges Admissions Service) personal statements, why take an apprenticeship, university life/courses, and Russell Group universities.

The date of the fair is **Tuesday, 14th November** and is being hosted at Brighton Amex Stadium. We will travel there by coach for a two-hour slot, from 10.30a.m. - 12.30p.m., and then return to school for the remainder of the afternoon. We believe our students would gain a great deal of information from this event, meeting prospective colleges, universities and apprenticeship providers.

There are 45 spaces available and it is therefore on a first come first served basis. We kindly request that each student pays a contribution of **£12.10**, payable via ParentPay, to cover the coach fee. If you require assistance with payment, please email or call me on the contact details below. Students are required to wear school uniform and bring food/drink along with them. Those students that receive free school meals will have a packed lunch provided for them.

College Applications

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that your child has had a good week back after the half term break.

You will find attached to this email information which shows students how to choose the courses/apply for their college placement, should your child wish to do this at home.

In order to move onto this stage of the college application process, the initial 'My Profile' section of Careers East Sussex must be complete (a number of students have been completing this, as well as their personal statement, during tutor time). If you/your child require guidance on completing the 'My Profile' section, or require their login details, please contact Sarah Rooney on the contact details below.

College applications need to be completed by **<u>Friday 1st December</u>** at the very latest as all applications need to be checked, given a reference by tutors and sent to the colleges prior to the Christmas holidays.

Due to the vast amount of applications being submitted by schools in the local area, we strongly recommend that applications are submitted earlier than this, by **Friday 24**th **November**. The sooner the application is submitted, the quicker your child will have an interview and offer of a college place.
