YEAR 11 PROM – FRIDAY 3rd July 2026

Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

This year's Year 11 Prom will be held at the Cavendish Hotel on Friday 3rd July 2026. The cost of the ticket is £60 per student and includes the following:

- Hire and use of the Cavendish Hotel with security
- Welcome fruit cocktail served in champagne flutes
- 2 course evening meal
- Table decorations, room decorations and balloons
- Magician entertainment
- DJ and dance floor use
- 1 x photo voucher for a professional photo per student
- Entry to a Grand Prize Draw

We hope that you are all as excited as we are, and will join us for an unforgettable evening to celebrate the end of your school journey. You should arrive from 6pm, with welcome cocktails available until 7pm. Students will then be invited into the evening meal, which will be served at 7.30pm. Any cars or vehicles dropping students off at the Cavendish Hotel, should approach from the west end of Grand Parade (heading towards the Pier) to minimise the amount of traffic disruption. Students will be permitted to use the main Coronet Bar to purchase soft drinks throughout the evening. The evening is due to finish at 11.30pm, however, students can be collected or leave earlier should they wish.

Payment can be made in 2 instalments. In order to secure your place at the Prom, your deposit payment of £30 needs to be made via ParentPay by Sunday 31st May 2026. Your second instalment of £30 should be paid by Friday 12th June 2026. **The cost of the ticket can be paid in full if preferred via ParentPay.** Once you have made your payment, please click on the following link to make selections for menu choices for both the main and dessert courses, as well as making us aware of any dietary requirements or allergies. We are also asking for preferential choices about those you wish to sit with to enjoy the meal, with up to 3 other students who can be named:
