

GCSE results day for Year 11 pupils is on Thursday 22nd August 2024.

Results day will provide Year 11 students with their final GCSE and vocational results for 2024.

We will be inviting students into school to collect their results in person from **10.00am** until **12 noon** on results day.

If they are unable to collect in person, the school will need a letter or email from the student (using their own email address) confirming the name of the person collecting on their behalf. The nominated person must bring in photo ID.

Any uncollected results envelopes will be posted home first class on the afternoon of 22 August. Please ensure the school has your most up to date address if you have recently moved.

All exam boards have a system of post-results services. This can take the form of a clerical check, a review of marking of an examination script or the review of moderation of coursework. These are the various processes by which students can verify that their examination work has been marked accurately. Willingdon Community School follows all procedures identified in the latest version of the JCQ publication post-results Services.
