

Dear Parents and Carers

I hope this letter finds you and your family well.

Please find below details of the Summer School, which will take place the week of **Monday 29th July to Friday 2nd August 2024.**

The full week costs £150.00 or individual days are £45. Once your interest is registered, we will forward you the financial form directly.

Your child will not be expected to wear their school uniform. However, they must come appropriately dressed for taking part in physical activities. This means, for health and safety reasons, they should wear trainers or plimsolls and not any form of open shoe. In addition, tops should not allow midriffs to be shown and shorts should be of an appropriate length. Please be aware that some activities will be outside (weather permitting) so sun cream and a hat are advisable. Water will be available throughout the day, so please ensure your child has a water bottle.

The plan for each day is as follows:

- 08.30am 9.00am Students arrive at the entrance by the Sports Hall and registration
- 9.00am 10.00am Session 1
- 10.00am 10.15am Break
- 10.15am 11.15am Session 2
- 11.15am 11.30am All students/staff return main hall
- 11.30pm 12.30pm Lunchtime students to bring their own packed lunch
- 12.30pm 13.30pm Session 3
- 13.30pm 13.45pm Break
- 13.50pm 14.45pm Session 4
- 14.45pm -15.00pm All students/staff to meet in the main hall to reflect on the day
 - 15.00pm Students will be dismissed from the Sports Hall entrance ready for collection/to walk home

We will confirm the activities nearer the time depending on numbers but there will be a range from creative to sporting opportunities. All staff are employed by ESCC and work at Willingdon Community School. All staff have full enhanced DBS and there will be safeguarding and first aid support each day.
