

YEAR 10 THORPE PARK TRIP – TUESDAY 21st JULY 2026

Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for choosing Thorpe Park for Activities Day on Tuesday 21st July. We have received your payment via ParentPay and this has secured a place for your child.

Important Details:

- **Date of Trip:** Tuesday 21st July
- **Meeting Time:** 7.20am in the Canteen
- **Transport:** We will travel via coach to Thorpe Park, these will depart Broad Road at 7.45am
- **Return Time:** We will leave Thorpe Park aiming to be back at school between 6.30-8pm (traffic depending)
- **Park Time:** Students will have between 10am and 5.30pm to enjoy the rides and attractions

What Students Need to Bring:

- A packed lunch. Please be aware that Thorpe Park has a contactless only policy, so students will need to use Apple Pay, Android Pay or debit/credit cards if they wish to purchase food etc on the day.
- A refillable water bottle
- Students can wear their own clothes, but these must be weather-appropriate and suitable for the conditions, as well as comfortable for going on the rides
- Optional items: hat, sunglasses, sun cream, lightweight raincoat (depending on the weather)

On arrival to the park, once inside, students will have the chance to explore in small groups. They must remain in groups of a minimum of 3 at all times and will be issued with an emergency contact number should they need to use it. Staff will be located at a central point during the day, should they need to speak with a member of staff in person and this will be the main meeting point for students to check in throughout the day. Any student who does not follow Thorpe Park's safety guidelines or does not meet our school standards/expectations may lose the privilege of independent time around the park and will spend it supervised with staff instead.

We expect all students to show excellent behaviour, responsibility, and respect for the staff and public whilst at Thorpe Park at all times throughout the day.
