



Dear Parents/Carers

Year 11 are doing incredibly well so far with their exams; we have had a full cohort present at every exam so far. Thank you so much all your support in making this happen.

On the GCSE exam timetable 2024 found on our school website, you will have noticed that there are three contingency days. These are set by the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ)

The contingency dates are as follows:

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June afternoon

Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June afternoon

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June all day

The contingency days are in place in case there is a major national or local disruption which causes an exam to be cancelled, so allowing it to be rescheduled into one of these dates. Students need to be available to attend school on these days in case an exam is rescheduled.

GCSE results day is Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August. Students are able to pick up results in person from the school between 10am -12pm. If they are unable to collect in person, the school will need a letter or email from the student (using their own email address) confirming the name of the person collecting on their behalf. The nominated person must bring in photo ID when collecting the results.

All exam boards have a system of post-results services. This can take the form of a clerical check, a review of marking of an examination script or the review of moderation of coursework. These are the various processes by which students can verify that their examination work has been marked accurately. Willingdon Community School follows all procedures identified in the latest version of the JCQ publication Post-Results Services. Please refer to the information that will be made available on the school website this week, it will detail key dates and fees associated with the different post-result services available.
