Blood Brothers -White Rock Theatre Hastings- Thursday 14th November 2019

As part of your son/daughter's GCSE Drama course; students are required to explore a set play in the written exam. One text the students will be studying next year will be 'Blood Brothers'. Blood Brothers tells the story of the Johnstone twins, Mickey and Eddie, brothers separated at birth who reunite and become friends in their childhood, unaware of their relation to each other or of the consequences their relationship will bring about.

The production will be touring in November, so it will be a great opportunity for the students to see the live performance. This experience will be extremely valuable when we have to analyse and evaluate the acting and design elements in class later in the year. It will also give the students an important opportunity to see their subject in a professional context.

We are planning to go to see the show on **Thursday 14th November 2019**. We will be leaving school at **1pm** and returning to school around **6pm**. We will be travelling to the theatre by Coach and then walking to the Theatre, therefore we will have the highest expectations about behaviour as the students will be representing the school. Students are required to wear school uniform.

The full cost of the trip is £32.22 this includes ticket, insurance and transport costs. Payment is required by **Monday 11th November 2019** and can be paid by ParentPay only.
