### **Home-based learning – update for students (Years 7-10)**

**Always start by looking at Edulink.** All subjects will set the tasks on Edulink as homework, telling you when the work needs to be complete and showing you where you need to click onto other platforms like Google Classroom, MyMaths, Seneca and IXL.

You should be completing **2-3 hours per week for English/Maths/Science and 1-2 hours for every other subject.** If you are in Year 10, expect to be set work at the higher end of these ranges.

Check your instructions to see **which work you need to submit and how you should submit it.**

We are aiming to **reward students with achievement points** whenever you complete good work.

We have more plans in the pipeline for fine-tuning your home-based learning, but these simple guidelines should help you keep on top of everything.

Please keep up the good work - and good luck this week. If you are not engaging with the work, there's a good chance that your teachers will be contacting your parents to help you get it done.
