Wicked - Apollo Theatre London- Wednesday 11th December 2019

The Drama Department are planning to take a group of KS3 students to see a live theatre performance in London before Christmas. The production we will see is the spectacular 'Wicked' at the Apollo Theatre in the West End. Wicked is a prequel to The Wizard of Oz and goes through the life of Elphaba who is a nice girl until the disapproval of society turns her **Wicked**. This is the story of how Elphaba becomes the **Wicked Witch of the West**, and it involves love, loss, hatred, envy and an unwillingness to accept anything that is different. It will also give the students an opportunity to see the subject in a professional context.

We are planning to go to see the show on **Wednesday 11th December 2019**. We will be leaving at **10.30am** and returning to school around **8pm**. We will be travelling to the theatre by coach and then walking to the Theatre, therefore we will have the highest expectations about behaviour as the students will be representing the school. Students are expected to wear full **school uniform**.

The full cost of the trip is **£45.38** - this includes ticket, insurance and transport costs. Payment is required by **Friday 29th November 2019** and can be paid by ParentPay.
