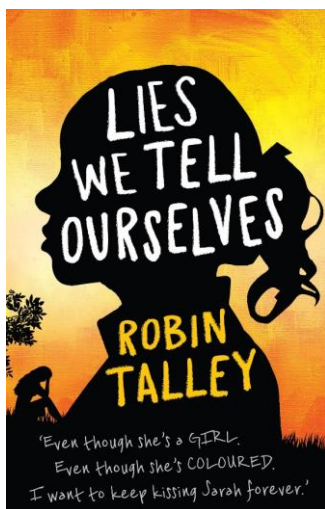
CANTEEN ACCOUNTS
