**YEAR 9 GCSE STYLE FIELDWORK ASSESSMENT**

We write to inform you that your son/daughter will be participating in a field trip to fulfil the requirements of the compulsory fieldwork assessment that forms part of the Year 9 programme of study in Geography. The date and time of the trip are detailed above. The trip provides the preparatory data for one of the key Year 9 assessments in Geography for the year. It will further provide your son/daughter with a range of transferable skills that will be needed in their future GCSE subjects.

The main title of the work is:

**'Should housing be developed on the land adjoining Filching Close?'**

The Year 9 programme of study includes the challenges of urbanisation, designing field work investigations and the development of national parks. This trip will address elements of each of these topics. We have organised a fieldtrip to a local section of the South Downs, going no further than Butts Brow. Students will walk from school to the section of the Downs that is the focus of this assessment. They will be accompanied at all times by members of staff.

Students should make their way to and from school as normal. As your child is participating in the morning session, he/ she will register with their tutor as normal and remain in tutor time until 9.00am when they should proceed to meet the rest of the group in the canteen. They will return to school by 11:50am in time to register for Period 4. As they will miss break, they should take a snack that they can eat during the morning.

On the day of the fieldwork your son/daughter must come to school in their school uniform; however appropriate footwear and jackets, sun cream or hats may be needed in light of the changeable weather conditions on the day. Please check the forecast for the day. This trip is a compulsory part of the Year 9 Geography course, and due to the low costs, there will be no charge.

The school holds a medical consent form on behalf of your child but if there have been any changes, please would you indicate on the permission slip so that we can update our records accordingly. Poor behaviour/low attendance will not be tolerated at the Willingdon Community School. Therefore, the school reserves the right to cancel a student's participation in a trip if behaviour /attendance does not reach our expected high standards.
